- Curriculum vitae et Studiorum;
- Photocopy of Identity Card
- A short research project on the subject;
- PhD or proof of equivalent period of research;
- Any other documents (publications, awards, scholarships, references referring to periods of work or study in Italian or foreign research centers, etc.) that might be useful for the evaluation;
- Equivalent Financial Indicator Index (ISEE certification)

Any applications received after 20 July 2015, or that are received incomplete of the requested documentations will not be taken into consideration. The applicant has to declare, under his own responsibility, not to be the recipient of another Award, and / or scholarship or educational grant for the same period of the Award. The applicant must not have any paid full-time professional or advisor collaboration with public or private entities or have any full-time employment with the some entities.

Applications will be evaluated unquestionably by the committee:

- Prof. Giacomo Carlo Sturniolo – the President of the “R. Farini” Association
- Dr. Francesca Galeazzi – the Secretary of “R. Farini” Association
- Prof. Fabio Farinati- the Treasurer of the “R. Farini” Association

The selection will be made according to the following criteria:

Degree mark

- Less than 100 - 0 points
- For each point from 100 to 109 – 0.50 points
- For full marks - 6 points
- For praise - 7 points

Doctoral Dissertation (quality and relevance of the thesis) - maximum 7 points

- No / little relevance (depending on quality) - up to 3 points
- medium / high relevance (depending on quality) - up to 7 points

Activities elective or equivalent certificates pertinent to the matter and carried out within the obtained degree (maximum 3 points)

- For each elective activity - up to 1 point

PhD or equivalent research period up to 7 points

Printed publications or works that have been accepted in full by scientific journals pertinent to the matter (maximum 5 points)

- Each publication or work - up to 1 point

Brief research project on the subject - up to 7 points

Equivalent Financial Indicator Index (ISEE certification)

- Up to € 15,000.00 - 15 points
- From € 15,000.00 to € 25,000.00 - 10 points
- From € 25,000.00 to € 40,000.00 - 5 points
- From € 40,000.00 to € 50,000.00 - 2.5 points
- More than € 50,000.00 - 0 points

The Award winner will be informed by registered mail and by e-mail. All participants will receive written notice of the results of the selection, within thirty (30) days from the application deadline.

The winner will be required to submit the report of the results obtained, in the form of Abstract, during the Symposium 2016 of the “R. Farini Association”

The Scholarship will be paid to the candidate monthly; the first one after the receipt of communication of the date of starting activity.
